Welcome

Dear Parents,

Welcome to our Bus Service Guide for the 2025/26 academic year. This sets out the details of the 5 bus routes that we will be operating from September 2025, including timetable and fare information, plus the details of the 2 new routes (Caversham and West London). We are continuing to work with Vectare, a specialist school transport management company which is responsible for over 2.5 million school journeys per annum, and will be using its systems for the smooth administration of our bus services. This system is used by hundreds of schools across the country and it has a number of features that we believe parents will welcome.

If you would like your child to use one of the bus services in the coming year, either on a regular or ad-hoc basis, please sign up at standrewsberkshire.vectare.co.uk as soon as possible. All bookings must be made via this website and this guide provides details on how to do that. There is also a Parent User Guide on the website itself which should answer most queries, but any remaining queries can be directed to the Vectare team at standrewsberkshire@vectare.co.uk. Payment for using the service will be made at the point of booking and your child's name will automatically be added to the bus register.

This online booking system means that you can book bus transport at any time, including adding one-off bookings, until one hour before the bus is due to depart from the school. Once you have made a booking, either regular or ad-hoc, could I please emphasise the importance of marking the trip as **'Not Travelling'** on every occasion that your child does not need to use the bus as this will help to ensure that the service can run as efficiently as possible.

All of the routes are operated with our own directly employed drivers and our own well-maintained vehicles. Regular drivers are allocated to the same route each day so you and your child can get to know the driver on your route.

There have been no revisions to the three routes from last year but we have added two new routes, so I advise that you use the interactive journey planner on the website to enter your postcode and find your closest bus stop.

Both Vectare and the School are continually seeking to make improvements to our service, including adding additional routes in the future, so do please contact us if you have any suggestions.

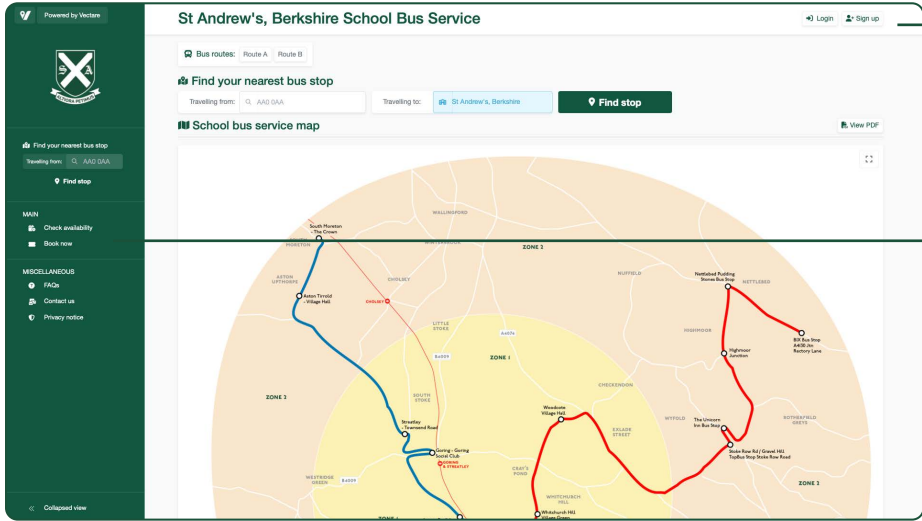

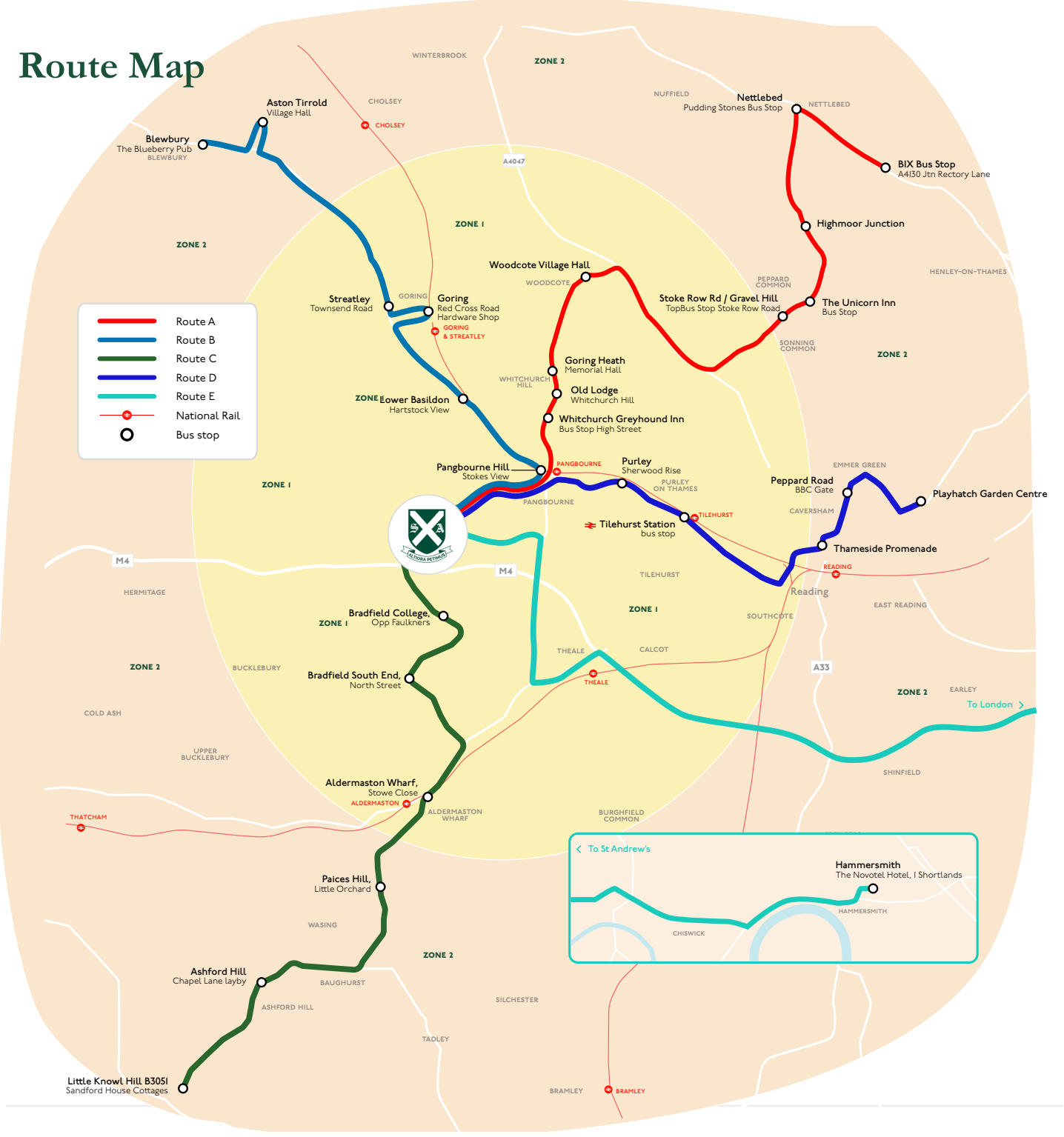

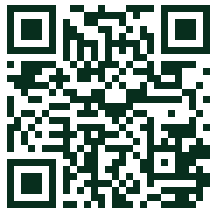

Terms & Conditions

1.

This agreement is made between all school bus passengers, their parents and St Andrew’s School in order to provide safe, comfortable and civilised journeys for all passengers.
2.

Arrangements for pupils' journeys to and from school are the responsibility of their parents. To assist with discharging this responsibility, the School provides a School Bus Service. Parents are responsible for their children at all times including both prior to boarding and after alighting. Please make sure that there is no pupil left on their own when you collect your son or daughter from the bus stop.
3.

Transport on the School Bus Service must be arranged and paid in advance through the online booking system.
4.

Bookings are generally non-refundable in the event of a pupil failing to travel. The School may, at it's discretion, issue a credit against future journeys in certain limited circumstances eg. a pupil is unable to travel due to a school commitment or because he/she is boarding.
5.

6.

Each pupil for whom an online form has been submitted will be added to a bus list detailing the service they travel on and their bus stop. Their name will appear on a list which will be checked by the driver.
7.

It will be the parent's responsibility to inform the School via the '**Contact Us**' form on the School Bus Service website if they no longer wish for their child to use the School Bus Service. A full term's notice must be given by a parent prior to the removal of a pupil from the School Bus Service.
8.

No pupil is permitted to travel on the School Bus Service if not pre-booked for that bus. Other arrangements for journeys to and from school must be made by the pupil or their parents.
9.

Pupils must travel to and from the School in full school uniform or full school tracksuit or other appropriate clothing.
10.

Pupils should be at the bus stop five minutes before the scheduled time of departure to ensure they do not miss the bus. Drivers will not wait past the scheduled departure time.
11.

Good conduct is required at all times. Shouting, use of inappropriate language, dropping litter, playing loud music or any other misbehaviour is strictly forbidden, and pupils must not needlessly talk or distract the driver. Pupils must ensure that any online activity will not cause distress to others and normal school sanctions, or breach of guidelines, will be enforced.
12.

Except when embarking or disembarking, or when asked to move to a different seat in accordance with condition 13, all passengers must remain seated with their seatbelts fastened correctly.
13.

Whilst on a school bus, all passengers must accept the authority of a member of staff or driver, who may ask them to obey any reasonable instruction such as pick up litter, cease from certain actions or to move to a different seat.
14.

Failure to comply with these conditions may result in the matter being referred to the Deputy Head, Pupil Wellbeing and may result in disciplinary action, including temporary or permanent withdrawal of permission to use the School Bus Service.
15.

St Andrew's School aims for 95% of journeys to operate within the transport industry window of tolerance of one minute early to five minutes late, however timings may vary due to traffic conditions or unforeseen circumstances. There may be some adjustment needed to the timings in the first weeks of term when new routes are introduced.
16.

Only pupils in Years 2 and above will be able to use the bus service; Pupils in Year 1 and Reception may be permitted to travel with an older sibling, but this would be at the School's discretion and subject to review.
17.

The School reserves the right to amend or withdraw published services, having provided one month's notice, for instance if there is insufficient demand or for operational reasons.
